RE: North Texas Groundwater Conservation District Board Representation

Dear Judge Self and Members of the Collin County Commissioners Court:

The legislation creating the North Texas Groundwater Conservation District ("District") in 2009 contains a provision for three (3) representatives to be appointed to the District Board of Directors by the Collin County Commissioners Court. The provisions in the enabling legislation provide that one (1) of these positions is to be filled by a slate of not more than three (3) nominees provided to the Commissioners Court by the largest water producer in Collin County, which is the City of Anna.

As you are aware, Phillip Sanders was filling the appointment for the current term for the representative of the largest water provider in Collin County, which runs through June 1, 2019. Mr. Sanders submitted his resignation to the Board of Directors, which was accepted at the January 9, 2018 Board Meeting. The appointment needed to fill the vacancy will serve the remaining term for the position, through June 1, 2019.

Subsequent to the resignation, the City of Anna has provided the attached resolution nominating Maurice Schwanke, City of Anna Interim City Manager, for the remaining term. I would like to request that you place an item on the next Commissioners Court agenda to provide an appointment to the Board of Directors.
