TERMINATION OF THE SEPTEMBER 12, 2016 MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN COLLIN COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AND THE CITY OF WYLIE, ACTING BY AND THROUGH THE WYLIE FIRE DEPARTMENT

Whereas, the City of Wylie Fire Department (hereinafter referred to as "WFD") and Collin County Department of Emergency Management, (hereinafter referred to as "CCDEM"), find their missions congruent and capabilities complimentary; and,

Whereas, WFD and CCDEM have a mutual interest in protecting the residents of Collin County during natural and man-made disasters and other emergency situations, and

Whereas, WFD and CCDEM maintain mutual aid agreements to provide response and recovery assistance from natural and man-made disasters, and other emergency situations, that may require the deployment of emergency resources, including the Mobile Incident Command Post (MICP), and

Whereas, WFD and CCDEM have a mutual interest in terminating the aforementioned Memorandum of Understanding, in accordance with Paragraph V. Procedures for Amendments and Termination, in order to effect the equipment transfer of the MICP to WFD;

THEREFORE, WFD AND CCDEM AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

I. Termination of agreement

This amendment serves to terminate the Memorandum of Understanding, by and between WFD and CCDEM entered into by same on September 12, 2016, in accordance with provisions established in paragraph V. of that MOU. This amendment serves as thirty (30) days written notice to each party and the effective date of the MOU termination will be thirty days after the last party to the termination has signed. This termination serves as a reaffirmation of the mutually supportive relationship, between the signatories, better suited to respond to the needs of our community.
