Commissioner Thomas asked Jon Kleinheksel, Public Works, to explain the issue and potential resolution and costs. Mr. Kleinheksel said TCEQ (Texas Commission on Environmental Quality) conducted a site inspection of the fuel tanks at the Public Works Service Center and cited two violations of the Texas Water Code. The first violation involves the ATG (Automatic Tank Gauging) system which malfunctioned. This system monitors tank levels and fuel leaks electronically. The issue was addressed and fixed immediately. The second issue had to do with the records not being turned in on time for the ATG system.

Mr. Kleinheksel explained the fuel systems are approximately 30 years old. They have checked on the cost of installing new tanks at the Public Works Service Center and the Justice Center. The pricing came back at \$860,000 for the tanks and lines at the Service Center and \$1.6 million for the Justice Center. This budget cycle includes \$25,000 to hire a consultant to look at the entire fuel system.

Collin County Commissioners' Court Meeting Minutes September 24, 2018 Page 5 of 8 Commissioner Fletcher asked about the possibility of having an agreement with the surrounding cities to purchase fuel so the County doesn't have the liability of TCEQ requirements. Mr. Kleinheksel said they are currently looking into this. Commissioner Thomas said the cost to remove the County's tanks and go through the remediation process could be in excess of \$1 million. With no further comments, a motion was made to approve the item. (Time: 1:37 p.m.)
