VII. PRIOR INTERVENTIONS

Please include all relevant information regarding prior interventions and/or modifications: **This department has been working with J.D. since October 14, 2016. She was 11 years old at that time. Since this time, she has been hospitalized in Glen Oaks, Green Oaks, Seay Center, and Hickory Trails mental health hospitals for stabilization due to self-harm as well as suicidal attempts (over dosing and cutting) and homicidal threats. She has gone through counseling with a private Therapist at McKinney Neuropsychology. She is receiving Psychiatric care and medication through the Chickasaw Nation Behavioral Health Hospital in Ardmore, OK. She attended counseling with the Children's Advocacy Center. J.D. has attended a 6 week counseling program through Lifepath Systems where she received individual and family counseling twice per week. She completed Partial-Hospitalization at the Seay Center after being taken to Baylor Emergency Room for attempting to overdose. Ms. V.D., J.D.'s mother also completed a Crisis Intervention counseling through Hope's Door for domestic violence received from her ex-husband. In April 2017, J.D. began attending Intensive weekly counseling with Collin County Juvenile Probation Adolescent Therapist, Ms. Rhonda Solley, MEd, MA, MSSW, LMSW. Although, J.D.'s probation expired on November 24, 2017, she continued weekly counseling with Ms. Solley. In December 2017, it was noted that Ms. Solley recommended Ms. V.D. seek a residential treatment center due to J.D.'s continuous self harm. She was eventually referred back to this department in February 2018 and was adjudicated and placed in the Collin County Post-Adjudication Detention Center on April 25, 2018. She received group and individual therapy while in the program. On August 27, 2018 she was unsuccessfully discharged from the program for new offenses of Assault Public Servant and Harassment of a Public Servant. J.D. bit and spit on Juvenile Supervision Officers.**
