Safety Concerns/Issues

- * VISIBILITY TO THE PUBLIC TO WARN OF HAZARDS DURING ACCIDENT/STRANDED MOTORISTS/ETC
- * VISIBILITY FOR SAFETY OF DEPUTIES DURING AN EMERGENCY SITUATION RESPONDING TO CALLS
- * PROTECTION USING VEHICLE AS COVER IN CRITICAL INCIDENTS IN THE FIELD(ballistic door panels)
- * VISIBILITY WHILE ASSISTING WITH PERIMETERS ASSISTING OTHER AGENCIES
- * CONSTABLES COULD BE UTILIZED MORE WITH NEW DISPATCH ZONES/AREAS IN 2019
- * VICARIOUS LIABILITY TO COUNTY IF VEHICLES NOT EQUIPPED PROPERLY
- ALL BLUE LIVES MATTER

Critical Incidents Within Precincts

- Aggravated assault turned into vehicle pursuit resulting in fatality accident (Wylie-Farmersville)
- * Burglary suspects fleeing with high powered rifles taken in burglary(Celina)
- * Murder suspect captured by constable's office (Anna)
- * Numerous accidents in inclement weather conditions(all over the county)
- * Richardson PD officer slain and our deputy was in that complex minutes prior serving papers(Richardson)
- * Assisted RPD throughout the crime scene eventually escorting body to M E office
- * Plano PD shooting and our deputy was in than complex minutes after incident serving papers(Plano)
- * Stabbing at Walmart and deputy constables help apprehend suspect(Princeton)
- * McKinney PD assaulted and our deputy was the first law enforcement on scene during the incident(McKinney)
- * Stabbing suspect assisted in arrest by deputy constables(Celina)
- * Assisted in many other emergency type incidents involving different precincts within the county utilizing the emergency equipment inside and outside vehicle
- * Mutual aid to DPD shooting July 7th downtown shooting resulting in 5 deaths of police officers

Budget Concerns

- * Sent email to Mrs. Gray/Dayne Shepherd April 2018 reference Taurus being discontinued
- * Discovered transitioning to Ford Explorer that some emergency equipment might not be interchangeable
- * Discovered Ford Explorer was being purchased after budget process for 2019 completed
- * Judge Self encouraged meeting with Mr. Kleinheksel reference the \$10,000.00 budgeted amount available
- * Met with Mr. Kleinheksel and he stated there should be enough in budget to outfit the vehicles without an issue
- * \$41,030.00 total per vehicle for 4 vehicles totaling \$164,120.00.
- * Mr. Kleinheksel had instructions not to add any new equipment without authority from commissioner's court
- * Today we are asking permission to add new equipment to be standard when ordered from this budget forward
- * Standardization is the ultimate goal and appears to be most economical for Public Works ordering vehicles
- * In future budgets, the Constable's should include equipment needed on vehicles at budget workshops
