1. Judge Self called to order the Special Session meeting of the **Collin County Commissioners' Court** at 11:00 a.m.

2. Public Comments.

Ceremony to honor Collin County fallen warriors.

Judge Self thanked everyone for attending the ceremony honoring five of Collin County's Fallen Warriors. The Judge introduced Colin Kimball, an Air Force Veteran and creator of the portraits, and R. D. Foster, Vietnam Veteran, to read a short biography on each of the five Fallen Warriors:

Lowell E. Kinney, 22, Celina, US Army Air Corps, 2nd Lt. 423 Bomber Squadron. Killed in action on November 9, 1942.

Jim B. Goodner, 21, McKinney, US Army Air Corps, 2nd Lt. Bombardier/Navigator of B17 Flying Fortress, 612th Bombardment Squadron. Killed in action on April 11, 1944.

Jimmy Doyle, 25, McKinney, US Army Air Corps, S/Sgt. Killed in action on September 1, 1944.

Lanny Hale, 24, Wylie, US Army, Sp4 Class, 198th Light Inf. Brigade. Killed in action on February 8, 1968.

Jerry Wayne Combest, 25, Wylie, US Army, Sp4 Class, 25th Infantry Division. Killed in action on August 21, 1968.

3. Consent agenda to approve:

Judge Self commented on the young ages of the honorees which ranged from 21 to 25 years old. It is young men and women that fight our wars, and they will continue to be sent into harm's way. The Judge recognized the Veterans in attendance and thanked them for their service. He also recognized family and friends of the honorees who were in attendance.
