Consider Proposed FY 2019 Budget Re:

Background:

The budget has been reviewed and approved by the Board of Directors and it is recommended for adoption by the membership at the Luncheon to be held on December 13, 2018.

The budget estimates, for all programs, revenue of \$18,426,129 and expenses of \$18,215,691, with net revenue of \$210,438.

Noted changes in the FY 2019 from the FY 2018 budget are:

- Reviewed and recalculated General Class budget;
- No unrelated business income is anticipated in FY2019; and
- Decreased payroll costs in the TechShare budget is due, in part, to Sogeti Smartsource agreement.

Details of the budget are in the Recommended Resolution.

Recommended Resolution:

RESOLVED by the Membership of the Texas Conference of Urban Counties that the budget for FY 2019, as proposed by the Board of Directors, is approved as follows:

Texas Conference of Urban Counties Budget Policy FY 2019

1. The 2019 Budget for the Texas Conference of Urban Counties has the following programs: General, Policy, TechShare and Texas Indigent Healthcare Association. TechShare has the following programs for 2019 under its structure: JCMS Resource, Prosecutor Resource, Indigent Defense Resource, Court Implementation, Court Resource, and Jail Development.

- 2. The General Class will be used for indirect overhead costs such as downtown rent, secondary employee medical insurance policy, telecommunication costs such as the server maintenance for the entire Association, legal fees, meetings expenses related to Association business not specific to Policy or TechShare, payroll costs related to accounting and technical support for the Association, and other costs not specifically allocated to a program or resource. The actual General Class expenses will be allocated monthly in accordance with the approved Budget percentages. The Budget percentages are calculated as the weighted average of total payroll costs based upon time allocation estimates for each employee/contractor included in the General Class.
- 3. If a Program budgets an increase in revenue for the coming fiscal year, the time allocation estimates by employee/contractor will be reevaluated before the final CUC budget is approved.
- 4. Unrelated business income will be accounted for in the Policy class.
- Some expenses are grouped into categories with subcategories for each. It is intended those subcategories be managed at the category level for budget compliance. Those categories are: Other Expenses, IT Systems, Meetings, Staffing and Travel.
- 6. Depreciation in this budget is the expense on existing assets only. New asset purchases are budgeted as Furniture, Fixtures and Equipment (FF & E).
- 7. Equipment purchases accounted for as Fixed Assets will be depreciated over the equipment's useful life. The amount of any expense that will be incurred in the current year for a particular fixed asset will be equal to the depreciation on that specific asset. Future years' depreciation on that equipment will then be budgeted in the Depreciation expense account.
- 8. No state funds will be used to support the Policy program of the Urban Counties. A separate bank account is maintained for state funds. Those funds will be used only to pay direct costs on projects and resources the State is currently participating in and funding.
- 9. All TechShare resources and newly created projects will be assessed an Association Services Fee of 4%, calculated on total revenues. No association fee will be assessed on costs allocated to a State agency. The board may adjust the rate of the association fee paid on revenue from non-state agency participants so that the total association fee collected for the resource is 4% of the total resource revenue, or a lessor amount as appropriate. The Board may waive the Association Services Fee on newly created projects as it deems appropriate.
- 10. A salary differential account is used to budget for the difference between total actual salaries and 105% of that amount. Management will adjust this account when the Executive Director approves a salary increase. A separate salary schedule is prepared and included for Board discussions, but not published as

part of the budget. No salary may be paid that exceeds the budgeted salary maximum for that position.

11. Any changes to the approved budget will be handled through a budget amendment to be approved by the Board.
