





NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Newark Cultural Education Facilities Finance Corporation (the "Corporation"), a nonprofit corporation created by the City of Newark, Texas pursuant to Chapter 337, Texas Local Government Code, will hold a public hearing on March 14, 2019, commencing at 10:00 a.m. at 17301 Preston Road, Dallas, Collin County, Texas, to provide an opportunity for all interested persons to be heard with respect to a proposed loan from Frost Bank (the "Bank") to the Corporation in the maximum amount of \$35,000,000 and a proposed loan from the Corporation to The June Shelton Landmark Foundation, a Texas non-profit corporation (the "Borrower") in the same amount (collectively, the "Loans"); all pursuant to a Loan Agreement by and among the Corporation, the Bank and the Borrower.

The Loans are being made for the purpose of (A) financing the renovation of an existing building with approximately 320,000 square feet and equipping the property to be used for educational, administrative, athletic, science and classroom purposes located at 17301 Preston Road, Dallas, Collin County, Texas and (B) paying certain expenses in connection with the issuance of the Loans. The Project is, or will be, owned by the Borrower. The Loans are not payable out of taxes and are secured by and payable solely from funds provided by the Borrower.

All interested persons are invited to attend the hearing to express their views, both orally and in writing, with respect to the Loans and the Project. Any interested persons unable to attend the hearing may submit their views in writing to the President of the Board of Directors of the Corporation c/o Orrick, Herrington & Sutcliffe LLP, Attn: Hoang Vu, 609 Main Street, 40th Floor, Houston, Texas 77002, prior to the date scheduled for the hearing.
