## ATTACHMENT E

### Questions & Answers from Pre-Bid 7/11/2019

Q: Should Cement Treated Base (CTB) be plant mixed?

A: Cement Treated Base should be supplied from a batch plant and meet TxDOT strength requirements.

Q: What are your expectations regarding lime slurry?

A: It is anticipated that lime and cement slurry will be injected into the base through the reclamation machine during the reclamation process. The contractor may submit a request for a different method of placing the slurry, however the full depth reclamation will only be paid once regardless of any additional mixing required if the slurry is not injected during the process.

Q: What category is the two course chip seal application going to be under and what category will the single course seal coat application be under?

A: The two course application is part of the FDR category while the single course is part of the asphalt category.

Q: What are expectations for the Traffic Control Flagging?

A: Flagging assumes two total flaggers per day; one on each end of the project.

Q: How will this be awarded?

A: Collin County anticipates the award of one vendor per category and will be based on the total for that category (see Special Conditions and Specifications 4.14). County anticipates every line item within a category will receive a bid in order to be considered for award of that category, but not every category needs to be bid on.
