4.0 SPECIAL CONDITIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS

- 4.1 Purpose: The intended use/purpose for this Invitation for Bid is to describe IFB 2019-161, Construction: Replacement of Doors in Collin County Detention Center and Minimum Security.
- 4.2 Mandatory Pre-Bid Site-Walk: A mandatory pre-bid site-walk will be held on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>August 27</u>, <u>2019 at 1:30 PM</u>. The location of the site-walk will be at the Collin County Detention Center Lobby, 4300 Community Ave., McKinney, TX 75071. All prospective bidders are requested to have a representative present. It is the bidder's responsibility to review the site and documents to gain a full understanding of the requirements of the Invitation for Bid.
- 4.3 Term: Provide for a contract commencing on the date of the award and continuing until the project is complete.
- 4.4 Funding: Funds for payment for Collin County expenditures have been provided through the Collin County budget approved by the Commissioners' Court for this fiscal year only. All other participating entities expenditures have been provided through their entity's governing body for this fiscal year only. State of Texas statutes prohibit any obligation of public funds beyond the fiscal year for which a budget has been approved. Therefore, anticipated orders or other obligations that arise past the end of the current fiscal year shall be subject to budget approval.
- 4.5 Price Reduction: If during the life of the contract, the vendor's net prices to its customers for the same product(s) and/or services shall be reduced below the contracted price, it is understood and agreed that Collin County shall receive such price reduction.
- 4.6 Delivery/Completion/Response Time: Vendor shall state the number of calendar days to complete services at the County's designated location after receipt of notice to proceed in the space provided on Attribute 3.
- 4.7 Delivery/Setup/Installation Locations: Locations for delivery and installation are Collin County Detention Center, 4300 Community Ave., McKinney, TX 75071 and Collin County Minimum Security, 4800 Community Ave., McKinney, TX 75071. Delivery, assembly, set-up and installation shall be included in the bid price.
- 4.8 Testing: Testing may be performed at the request of Collin County, by an agent so designated by the County, without expense to Collin County.
- 4.9 Samples/Demos: When requested, samples/demos shall be furnished to the County at no expense.
- 4.10 Approximate Expenditure: The approximate expenditure by Collin County for this project is \$60,000. Estimated expenditure does not constitute an order, but only implies the probable quantity the County will use.

- 4.11 Evaluation and Award: Award of the contract shall be made to the responsive bidder who submits the lowest and best bid meeting specifications.
- 4.12 Warranties: If within one year after final acceptance of the work by Collin County, any of the work or material is found to be defective or not in accordance with the specifications of the contract, the contractor shall correct it promptly after receipt of a written notice from the County to do so. This obligation shall survive termination or completion of the contract. The County shall give such notice promptly after discovery of the condition.

The contractor shall remove from the site all portions of the work which are defective or nonconforming and which have not been corrected unless removal is waived in writing by the County.

If any materials or equipment utilized in this contract are covered by a standard manufacturer's warranty greater than requirements specified herein, Contractor shall extend that coverage to Collin County.

4.13 Subcontractors: Contractor shall state names of all subcontractors and the type of work they will be performing on Attribute 7. If a Contractor fails to specify a subcontractor, then he shall be deemed to have agreed that he is fully qualified to perform the contract himself, and that he will fully perform the contract himself.

No Contractor whose bid is accepted shall (a) substitute any subcontractor, or (b) permit a subcontract to be voluntarily assigned or transferred or allow it to be performed by anyone other than the original subcontractor listed in the original bid without approval in writing from the Collin County Purchasing Department.

The successful Contractor further agrees that Collin County and its agents, servants and employees shall not be liable for any loss or damage resulting from personal injury, physical loss, harassment of or discrimination against employee or other violations of the provisions of this contract occasioned by the acts or omissions of the successful Contractor's subcontractors, their agents or employees. The indemnification provisions of this contract shall apply to all subcontractors.

4.14 Bonds: In accordance with V.T.C.A. 2253.021, a governmental agency that makes a public work contract with a prime contractor shall require the contractor, before beginning work, to execute to the governmental entity a Payment Bond if the contract is in excess of \$25,000.00 and a Performance Bond if the contract is in excess of \$100,000. Such bond shall be in the amount of the contract payable to the governmental entity and must be executed by a corporate surety in accordance with Section 1, Chapter 87, Acts of the 56th Legislature, Regular Session, 1959 (Article 7.19-1 Vernon's Texas Insurance Code).

- 4.15 Wage Scale: In accordance with The Texas Government Code, Title 10, Chapter 2258, Prevailing Wage Rates, the general prevailing wage rate has been determined for this locality for the craft or type of workman needed to execute work of a similar character of the project listed herein. The Contractor shall pay the prevailing wage rate in this locality to all his/her employees and subcontractors performing work on this project, and in no event shall the Contractor pay less than the rate shown in the following schedule. Reference Attachment C for current prevailing wage rates.
- 4.16 Bid Documents: Contractor shall notify Collin County prior to submitting a bid if the bid documents are missing scope, incomplete or are contrary to actual site conditions.
- 4.17 Execution of Contract: The person or persons, partnership, company, firm, association or corporation to whom a contract is awarded shall within ten (10) consecutive calendar days after such award, sign the necessary contract agreements and submit the required bonds entering into the required Contract with Owner. No contract shall be binding on Owner until it has been executed by Owner or his/her duly authorized representative, and delivered to the Contractor.
- 4.18 Substitutions: Brand names and model numbers provided in the specifications are intended to be descriptive, not restrictive. Collin County will accept equivalent brand equipment. No substitution will be considered unless written request has been submitted to Owner for approval at least seven (7) consecutive calendar days prior to the date for receipt of bids. A substitution request form shall be emailed to jgriffin@co.collin.tx.us. If Owner approves a proposed substitution, such approval will be set forth in an Addendum.
- 4.19 Project Requirements and Clarifications:
 - 4.19.1 Bidder is responsible for verifying actual dimensions, site conditions and materials required to complete the project prior to submitting a bid.
 - 4.19.2 Collin County shall not be responsible for contractor's equipment or personnel safety.
 - 4.19.3 Contractor shall dispose of all waste and removed materials from the work site at the Contractor's cost. Contractor shall not use County dumpsters.
 - 4.19.3.1 Any existing material to be reused during the project by the Contractor or retained by the County are noted in the specifications below.
 - 4.19.4 Once awarded the contract, mandatory background checks will be performed by Collin County and required for all persons who will work onsite.
 - 4.19.5 Work hours shall be Monday-Friday from 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM.
 - 4.19.6 A fulltime escort shall be required while contractor is working onsite. Contractor's tools shall be inventoried by County staff entering and exiting the Jail each day.
 - 4.19.7 Contractor shall clean work areas of all debris before leaving each day.

- 4.19.8 All hinge screws shall be star security screws.
- 4.19.9 Contractor shall protect security glass and flooring when welding.
- 4.19.10 All work completed by the Contractor shall be reviewed and deemed acceptable by a member of Collin County Facilities Maintenance Department prior to payment. Work found non-compliant shall be remedied by the Contractor at their own expense.
- 4.20 Scope: Contractor shall remove and dispose of existing doors; provide, install and paint new doors; and repair and paint door frames in the Collin County Adult Detention and Minimum Security Facilities per the following specifications. Contractor shall provide all equipment, components, materials, parts and skilled labor required to complete the work and include cleanup of the job site. All components shall be new and unused; rebuilt or refurbished components will not be accepted.
- 4.21 Specifications: Adult Detention Facility
 - 4.21.1 Recreation Yard Doors/Frames:
 - 4.21.1.1 Remove, dispose and replace existing doors and repair door frames in the following locations:
 - 4.21.1.1.1 Cluster 1B, Upper and Lower rec. yard doors
 - 4.21.1.1.2 Cluster 1C, Upper and Lower rec. yard doors
 - 4.21.1.1.3 Cluster 1D, Upper and Lower rec. yard doors
 - 4.21.1.1.4 Cluster 3B, Lower rec. yard door (the window in the existing door shall be removed and reused in the replacement door)
 - 4.21.1.1.4.1 The existing window frame in Cluster 3B, Lower rec. yard door may be removed and reused.
 - 4.21.1.1.4.2 Actual dimensions of the existing window in Cluster 3B, Lower rec. yard door are unknown. Awarded Contractor shall verify dimensions of existing glass prior to ordering new door.
 - 4.21.1.1.5 Cluster 3C, Upper rec. yard door
 - 4.21.1.2 Cut-out bottom ten (10) inches of each side of existing door frame.

 - 4.21.1.4.1 Quantity four (4), full mortise hinges, 4 ½" x 4 ½", Southern Folger FA/4.5FM-ICS or Collin County approved equal.
 - 4.21.1.4.2 Quantity two (2), knob pulls (one each side), Southern Folger 215C or Collin County approved equal.
 - 4.21.1.4.3 Quantity one (1), door closure manufactured by LCN 2215 Series High Security Overhead Concealed Door Closer with door position switch (DPS), Norton or Collin County approved equal.
 - 4.21.1.4.4 Weather stripping and door sweeps manufactured by Reese, Zero, Pemko or Collin County approved equal.
- 4.21.1.5 Prepare all surfaces and paint entire door frame and new door, including top and bottom of door, with one (1) coat primer and two (2) top coats.

- 4.21.2.4 Caulk new door frame with detention grade caulk.
- 4.21.2.5 Provide and install new detention hollow metal door with ninety (90) minute fire rating per the specifications on Attachment A-Jail Door Schedule to include the following hardware:
 - 4.21.2.5.1 Quantity three (3), full mortise hinges, 4 ½" x 4 ½", Southern Folger FA/4.5FM-ICS or Collin County approved equal.
 - 4.21.2.5.2 Quantity one (1), 4 1/2EH Electric Hinge, Southern Folger or Collin County approved equal.
 - 4.21.2.5.3 Note: contractor shall remove lock and knob closure from existing kitchen door and reinstall on replacement door.

- 4.21.2.6 Prepare all surfaces and paint entire door frame and new door, including top and bottom of door, with one (1) coat primer and two (2) top coats.
 - 4.21.2.6.1 Top coat shall be Sherwin Williams Industrial Enamel, color code PNT7, to match existing finishes.

4.21.3 Jail Kitchen Inmate Restroom Door:

- 4.21.3.1 Remove and dispose existing door
- 4.21.3.2 Provide and install new hollow metal door per the specifications on Attachment A-Jail Door Schedule.
- 4.21.3.3 All hardware shall be removed from existing door and installed on new door with the exception of the hinges.
- 4.21.3.3 Provide and install quantity four (4) new 4 ½" x 4 ½" stainless steel hinges, Hager BB1191 or Collin County approved equal.
- 4.21.3.4 Prepare all surfaces and paint entire door frame and new door, including top and bottom of door, with one (1) coat primer and two (2) top coats.
 - 4.21.3.4.1 Top coat shall be Sherwin Williams Industrial Enamel, color code PNT7, to match existing finishes.

4.21.4 Cluster 5D Slider

- 4.21.4.1 Remove existing slider door.
- 4.21.4.2 Remove, provide and replace existing electric locking slider assembly with one (1) Southern Steel 3165LX or Collin County approved equal.
- 4.21.4.3 Reinstall existing slider door.
- 4.21.4.4 The slider shall run smoothly without motor grinding or bouncing upon completion.
