RE: Recommendations for FY'19 Health Care Service Agreements

On January 24, 2019, the Collin County Health Care Advisory Board met and reviewed applications from non-profits requesting funding to provide health care services. Funding of **\$140,000 for non-profits** was approved during the FY 2019 budget process. As directed by the Board of Trustees, the Health Care Advisory Board made their funding recommendations, based on the following criteria:

Types of services limited for funding:

- Sick medical visits (provided by a licensed health care provider);
- Laboratory and x-ray services;
- Prescription drugs (generic when available); and
- Outpatient medical services (provided by a licensed health care provider).

Recipients of services must be Collin County, Texas residents who are:

- U.S. citizens or Legal Resident Aliens with more than 40 working quarters of U.S. employment; and
- Uninsured and have household incomes at or below 100% of the Federal Poverty Level.

After lengthy discussion and consideration, the Health Care Advisory Board **unanimously voted to recommend \$95,000.00**, in funding for the following non-profit agencies based on previous performance and utilization of past funds awarded:

Allen Community Outreach - \$ 30,000 (of \$48,570 requested) for sick medical visits, prescription assistance, laboratory and x-ray services.

The Samaritan Inn - \$30,000 (of \$40,000 requested) for sick medical visits and prescription assistance.

Community Health Service Agency, Inc. - \$25,000 (of \$50,000 requested) for sick medical visits, prescription assistance, laboratory and x-ray services.

Hope Clinic - \$10,000 (of \$50,000 requested) for prescription assistance. This agency is a new local clinic and it is their first time applying for this grant.

If approved by the Trustees, service agreements will be sent out to the non-profits for signature and the service agreements will be placed on court for final approval. The Advisory Board is also recommending that the remaining **unallocated amount of 45,000 be held in contingency for non-profits** if critical funding needs are identified during the fiscal year.
