An order of the Collin County Commissioners Court requesting the inclusion of the MPO's Proposed Updates to the 2020 Unified Transportation Program for Collin County.

Whereas, Collin County's transportation system is heavily dependent on the Texas Highway Systems for adequate mobility; and

Whereas, over the decades, Collin County has partnered with the Texas Transportation Commission ("Commission") and the Texas Department of Transportation ("TxDOT") to advance major transportation projects in Collin County and North Texas; and

Whereas, to accelerate the funding and construction of needed major highway projects in Collin County, the parties authorized the construction of toll roads in place of non-tolled state highways, to the financial benefit of TxDOT; and

Whereas, Collin County has been working cooperatively with TxDOT for the last several years to develop critical new major highway corridors to address the high rate of growth that is occurring in Collin County; and

Whereas, Collin County citizens have agreed to once again be a solid partner with TxDOT by approving a bond program in 2018 that will provide \$600,000,000 over the next five years for the development of critical new highway corridors with TxDOT; and

Whereas, the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the North Texas region allocated \$600,000,000 for construction of these new highways in the MPOs Ten-Year Plan, and the funding for the MPO's allocations depends on the Commission's inclusion of these projects in the Commission's UTP; and

Whereas, the Commission is scheduled to take action on the proposed changes to the 2020 UTP at its regular meeting on April 30, 2020;

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Commissioners Court of Collin County, Texas as follows:

- Section 1. requests that the funds shown in the North Texas MPO's Ten Year Plan for construction of major additional highways in Collin County be included in the 2020 Unified Transportation Program;
- Section 2: directs the Resolution to be transmitted to the members of the Texas Transportation

 Commission, the members of the North Texas legislative delegation and other interested stakeholders;

Section 3. that this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its adoption.

A motion was duly made, seconded, and carried unanimously by the court members in attendance during a regular session on April 20, 2020.
