Texas Health Trace Contact Tracing Implementation Confirmation Form

Collin County Health Care Services selects the following option as it relates to statewide contact tracing for COVID-19:

Option 1

Local Health Entity (LHE) will perform all case investigation and contact tracing activities within its jurisdiction. LHE is responsible for entering data into Texas Health Trace and/or working with DSHS to provide these data. LHE will ensure users of the system have completed Texas Health Trace system training, as well as Cybersecurity and HIPAA trainings. If LHE does not have Cybersecurity and/or HIPAA trainings, DSHS will provide access to these trainings.

\Box Option 2

LHE will perform all case investigations within its jurisdiction, and DSHS will perform all contact tracing activities. LHE is responsible for entering data into Texas Health Trace and/or working with DSHS on plans to provide these data. LHE will ensure users of the system have completed Texas Health Trace system training, as well as Cybersecurity and HIPAA trainings. If LHE does not have Cybersecurity and/or HIPAA trainings, DSHS will provide access to these trainings.

Option 3

DSHS will perform all case investigation and contact tracing activities for LHE. LHE will be able to access the system to obtain data and reports for its jurisdiction. LHE will ensure users of the system have completed Texas Health Trace system training, as well as Cybersecurity and HIPAA trainings. If LHE does not have Cybersecurity and/or HIPAA trainings, DSHS will provide access to these trainings.

I understand that, regardless of the option selected, I will be able to access the system to obtain data and reports for my jurisdiction. Also, as circumstances change, I will work with DSHS to revise the above option as appropriate.
