RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF COLLIN COUNTY, TEXAS, APPROVING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF AN ADVANCE FUNDING AGREEMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE COLLIN COUNTY JUDGE OR COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER AND SIGN THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN COLLIN COUNTY AND THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR AN OFF THE STATE SYSTEM BRIDGE REPLACEMENT OF THE CR 696 AT BRUSHY CREEK BRIDGE.

WHEREAS, Title 23 United States Code Section 144 authorizes federal funds to assist the states in the replacement or rehabilitation of deficient bridges located on public highways, roads, and streets, including those under the jurisdiction of local governments; and

WHEREAS, Collin County (Local Government) owns the bridge on a public road located at CR 696 at Brushy Creek, and the bridge is included in the approved off-state system federal-aid Highway Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Program (HBRRP) as authorized by Texas Transportation Commission Minute Order Number 115550, dated August 29, 2019, Control Section Job (CSJ) Number 0918-24-254, National Bridge Inventory Structure # 18-043-0-AA04-68-001; and

WHEREAS, the Highway Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Program provides for the funding of authorized bridge work at ninety percent (90%) with a required Collin County funding match of ten percent (10%) of preliminary engineering, construction engineering, and construction costs for the replacement of the CR 696 at Brushy Creek bridge; and

WHEREAS, the Collin County Commissioner's Court has approved and entering into the agreement for this Project by this resolution; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COLLIN COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF COLLIN COUNTY, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the Agreement having been reviewed by the Commissioner's Court of Collin County, Texas and found to be acceptable and in the best interest of the County and its citizens.

Section 2. That the County Judge or the County Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into and sign an advance funding agreement with the State of Texas, acting through the Texas Department of Transportation for the bridge replacement of the CR 696 at Brushy Creek bridge.

Section 3. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
