RE: CARES funding: Josephine Volunteer Fire Department

Honorable Court,

The Josephine Volunteer Fire Department (JVFD) has seen an increase in call volume due to the COVID-19 epidemic. They have been extremely effective in the recruitment of volunteer staff which include 8 full time professional paramedics, two of which are also licensed nurses, from surrounding full time fire departments. JVFD is also poised to assume responsibility for the response to the Magnolia Point MUD which will provide EMS services to 400 existing homes with 300 additional builds within the upcoming year further increasing potential exposure to COVID-19 patients. The MUD buildout is planned for 3,000 homes.

Currently the fire station does not have facilities for overnight stay or showers for decontamination after calls before the paramedics return home to their families. Decontamination is essential to limit the potential spread of COVID-19. Many of the volunteer staff have committed to regular overnight shifts if facilities are provided to them.

The Fire Department has received a bid from Rafter P Construction to expand the footprint of the station which will add shower and bunk room facilities. The bid and addition overview is attached to this memo. The Fire Department will pay all expenses associated with the renovation and have requested that Collin County reimburse the cost of the renovation with the use of CARES funding.

I respectfully ask the Commissioners' Court to consider and approve reimbursement of the Josephine Volunteer Fire Department fire station expansion utilizing CARES act funding upon completion of the project.
