The application asked for pop-up tents, folding tables and chairs, pull-cart, storage tubs, grid-walls (for hanging display) to be used at community events to promote the Wylie Historical Society.

The Grant request falls under the category of day-to-day operating expenses and supplies. From the 2019-2020 Guidelines & Application:

Page 2, Bullet Point 4: Funding will not be granted to fund day-to-day operating expenses, supplies, staff salaries, contract personnel, office rental, travel expenses, and other administrative costs of the organization's daily operations.

The request does not meet the requirements for historical preservation or education.

Page 5, VII. The Collin County Historical Commission Mission Statement:
