An order of the Collin County Commissioners Court adopting a policy.


The Collin County Commissioners Court hereby approves the adoption of a policy regarding Collin County's Relocation Assistance Program.

Section 21.046 of the Texas Property Code provides that a political subdivision of this State shall, as a cost of acquiring real property, pay moving expenses and rental supplements, make relocation payments, provide financial assistance to acquire replacement housing, and compensate for expenses incidental to the transfer of the property if an individual, a family, the personal property of a business, a farming or ranching operation, or a nonprofit organization is displaced in connection with the acquisition.


Section 21.046 of the Texas Property Code further provides that a political subdivision of this State shall provide a relocation advisory service for an individual, a family, a business concern, a farming or ranching operation, or a nonprofit organization that is compatible with the *Federal Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970*, 42 U.S.C.A. 4601, *et seq.*

The Commissioners Court intends for the attached policy to be construed to achieve its purpose. The Commissioners Court shall resolve any question regarding any interpretation of the policy. If any portion of the policy or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, that decisions shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portion of the policy. The Commissioners Court declares that it would have passed the policy and adopted each section, clause or phrase of the policy, independent of the elimination from the policy of any portion that may be declared invalid or unconstitutional. The provisions of the policy are declared severable.

A motion was made, seconded, and carried by a majority of the court members in attendance during a regular session on Monday, August 10, 2020.








