Re: Redesignation of County Road 400 as Myrick Ln, from FM 982 to new turnoff in the Princeton ETJ

Pursuant to the Collin County Addressing Policy, Court Order No. 2002-247-04-08 Section A-3, the City of Princeton has renamed and re-addressed their annexed sections of County Road 400. The rural property owners have been informed, and I respectfully request the following road redesignation and rural address updates be approved by Commissioners Court to preserve the consistency of 9-1-1 addressing:

Change: County Road 400 to: Myrick Ln (from FM 982 to the new turnoff in Princeton ETJ)

The rural address changes will be:

From 8186 COUNTY ROAD 400 to 225 MYRICK LN 8185 COUNTY ROAD 400 230 MYRICK LN

Maps 9J2, 9K2, 9K3.

The signage at the intersection of County Road 400 and County Road 447 is unincorporated area. The other affected road intersections are inside city limits.
