Re: Mass Gathering Permit – Outlaw Nation (Music and Arts Festival)

The Mass Gathering Permit for the Outlaw Nation Music and Arts Festival to be held April 17 & 18, 2021, at Myers Park and Event Center has been reviewed and approved by the Collin County Sheriff's Office. The event organizers estimate a maximum of 750 attendees at any given time with an estimated daily attendance of 5000. The organizers indicate they will be providing 12 security personnel to manage traffic direction and parking. Given the fact the event will be selling alcohol and has the potential to exceed crowd estimates, the Sheriff's Office recommends no less than six (6) uniformed deputies to provide security during the event. As long as the Collin County Fire Marshall's Office approves the event, I see no reason to object to the issuance of the Mass Gathering Permit.
