RE: Debris Monitoring Services

Honorable Court,

The Office of Emergency Management has been conducting a 5 year review of the Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan (CEMP) for Collin County. The Debris Management Plan is contained within the CEMP. We have determined there is a need to establish a Debris Monitoring Service in the event the County activates our Debris Hauler Contract. A RFP has been developed, with input from Purchasing and Public Works, to select a contractor for the purposes of a Debris Monitoring. This RFP has also been reviewed by the Texas Division of Emergency Management to assist in ensuring State and Federal guidelines have been met in the event the County would seek disaster recovery funds if available.

I respectfully request Commissioners' Court to consider and approve to advertise for bid: RFP 2021-234 Debris Monitoring Services. This RFP is for the monitoring of the County's Disaster Debris Hauler contractor following a debris generating disaster, such as a tornado or winter storm, in which the amount of debris exceeds the County's ability to abate it. The Debris Monitor will help ensure the Debris Hauler adheres to FEMA and State guidelines to maximize potential reimbursement of County expenditures incurred due to debris hauling.
