




The mission of the Children's Advocacy Center of Collin County is to provide safety, healing and justice to victims of child abuse



Children's Mental Health During COVID


- 1 in 5 adolescents report high levels of anxiety1 in 4 adolescents report high levels of depression
- ✓ Jan- April of 2021 mental health ER visits rose 72% compared to the last 2 years
- ✓ CAC had a 51% increase in suicide assessments last year
- All of this ON TOP of the trauma of being abused

BUILDING PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

New facility will house all members of the Multi-Disciplinary Team and will serve Northern Collin County

Capital Campaign was launched in January 2018 to raise \$10M, the estimated cost for the project at that time

Land at 380 and Central was made available by Independent Financial at a deeply discounted price

KDC is providing Project Management services on a pro-bono basis


The Capital Campaign was completed successfully in fall of 2020, with 100% participation by Board, Advisory Council and CACCC staff members

Construction began July 1, 2021, and the new facility will be fully operational by late summer 2022

When we open, our operating budget will increase by \$650,000 per year
