EMERGENCY SIREN EASEMENT**

§ KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

COUNTY OF COLLIN §

That **Collin County** of the State of Texas, in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars to me in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and in consideration of the special benefits to be derived by my property; by these presents do grant and convey unto the City of Lavon (GRANTEE), a municipal corporation, a emergency siren easement under, in and along the hereinafter described property for the purpose of constructing and maintaining said facilities on said property described in Exhibit "A" and shown on Exhibit "B" hereto.

To have and to hold the above described property unto the Grantee for the purposes hereinbefore provided, and Grantee shall have the right to go upon the same for the purpose of operating or repairing said facilities. That all expenses in the construction and maintenance of said facilities shall be at the expense of the Grantee and in the construction of said facilities, should the Grantee find it needful to remove any improvements now on above described property that such removal and the replacing of same shall be wholly at the cost of the Grantee.

No buildings, trees, shrubs, or other improvements or growths shall be constructed, reconstructed, or placed on or across the easement, said easement being hereby reserved for the purposes described herein. Grantee shall have the right to remove and keep removed all or parts of any buildings, trees, shrubs, or other improvements or growths which in any way may endanger or interfere with the construction, maintenance, or efficiency of its respective system without the necessity, at any time, of procuring the permission of anyone.

Notwithstanding anything contained herein to the contrary, in the event for a period of twelve (12) consecutive months (i) the easement is not used for the placement and operation of emergency siren equipment or (ii) emergency siren equipment located on the easement is taken out of use and/or abandoned, Collin County shall have the right to terminate this easement by filing notice thereof in the Official Public Records of Collin County, Texas, that a condition set forth herein exists, at which time this easement shall automatically terminate without the joinder of the Grantee.

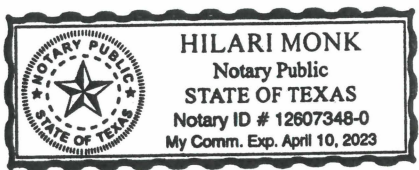

EMERGENCY SIREN EASEMENT

Being a 0.005-acre (225.00 square foot) tract of land, situated in the W. H. COMMENCING at a ½ inch iron rod found at the northeast corner of said 2.39 acre tract;

THENCE S 69°49'19" W, a distance of 318.21 feet to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**.

THENCE S 00°51'29" E, a distance of 15.00 feet to a point, said point being in the northern line of a 15-foot water line easement to the Bear Creek Special Utility District as recorded in instrument number 20200313000367660 of the OPRCCT;
