RE: Boundary Changes to Voting Precincts

Request Commissioners Court consideration and approval of the attached voting precinct boundary changes.

Growth within Collin County has resulted in fourteen (14) voting precincts to approach or exceed the maximum number of registered voters allowed in a voting precinct. (Section 42.006 of the Texas Election Code prohibits voting precincts from containing more than 5,000 registered voters.) Additionally, new U.S. Congressional, Texas House, Texas Senate and State Board of Education maps were signed into law by Governor Abbott in October 2021. In November 2021, Collin County Commissioners also approved new Commissioner and Constable/Justice of the Peace districts.

If approved, notice of the precinct boundary changes will be published in the Dallas Morning News once a week for three (3) consecutive weeks, per Section 42.035 of the Texas Election Code. Voting precinct changes will be effective January 1, 2022.
