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<b>SUMMARY</b>	<p>LifePath Systems will provide specialized mental health coverage 24 hours a day, 7 days a week on-site at the Collin County Detention Facility. One workforce member will be located on site around the clock (see coverage schedule below). Coverage is to be provided by a Qualified Mental Health Professional (QMHP) who is a member of the LifePath Mobile Crisis Outreach Team (MCOT). All QMHPs involved in the project will have a minimum of a bachelor's degree in psychology or related field and at least 3 years working in community mental health with individuals diagnosed with serious mental illnesses.</p> <p>QMHPs will work on-site in coordination with Detention Facility staff and healthcare contractors. On duty QMHP will have the following responsibilities at book-in:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Identify current or previous LifePath clients,</li> <li>2) Complete a MH evaluation for those who screen positive &amp;/or who are current or previous LifePath clients, and</li> <li>3) Determine level of watch.</li> </ol> <p>QMHP will be responsible for coordinating community-based mental health (MH), intellectual or developmental disabilities (IDD), and substance use disorder (SUD) services upon release of individuals identified with MH, IDD, or SUD needs.</p>
<b>DESIRED OUTCOME</b>	To improve the identification of individuals with mental health, intellectual or developmental disabilities, or substance use disorders at book-in and initiate recommendations for most appropriate care.
<b>BENEFITS OF PROJECT</b>	<p>Expected benefits include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Faster identification of individuals currently or previously in LifePath Systems services;</li> <li>• Earlier identification of those who may screen positive initially, but are not currently experiencing significant mental health or substance use issues;</li> <li>• Initiation of appropriate discharge planning prior to release of inmate.</li> </ul>

<b>PROJECTED SCHEDULE</b>	<p>We propose that QMHP's involved in this project work the following schedule:</p> <p>Monday through Friday:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shift 1: 7am – 3pm</li> <li>• Shift 2: 3pm – 11pm</li> <li>• Shift 3: 11pm – 7am</li> </ul> <p>Saturday and Sunday:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shift 1: 7am – 7pm</li> <li>• Shift 2: 7pm – 7am</li> </ul>
<b>PROJECTED BUDGET</b>	<p>\$280,000 annual budget</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Salaries = \$218,000</li> <li>• Benefits = \$52,416</li> <li>• Other Operating Expenses (training &amp; development, cell phone, computer user fees, general and malpractice insurance, etc.) = \$9,584</li> </ul>
<b>PROJECTED TEAM AND RESOURCE REQUIREMENTS</b>	<p>Team: 4.2 FTE's to provide 24 hours a day, 7 days a week coverage at the Detention Facility</p> <p>Resources Required: Will need access to facility, orientation to facility procedures, establishment as a member of the detention facility workforce with knowledge of chain of command and procedures for accessing care in the infirmary. Needs to have access to communications in the facility.</p>
