SUMMARY	LifePath Systems will provide specialized mental health coverage 24 hours a day, 7 days a week on-site at the Collin County Detention Facility. One workforce member will be located on site around the clock (see coverage schedule below). Coverage is to be provided by a Qualified Mental Health Professional (QMHP) who is a member of the LifePath Mobile Crisis Outreach Team (MCOT). All QMHPs involved in the project will have a minimum of a bachelor's degree in psychology or related field and at least 3 years working in community mental health with individuals diagnosed with serious mental illnesses.  QMHPs will work on-site in coordination with Detention Facility staff and healthcare contractors. On duty QMHP will have the following responsibilities at book-in:  1) Identify current or previous LifePath clients,  2) Complete a MH evaluation for those who screen positive &/or who are current or previous LifePath clients, and  3) Determine level of watch.  QMHP will be responsible for coordinating community-based mental health (MH), intellectual or developmental disabilities (IDD), and substance use disorder (SUD) services upon release of individuals identified with MH, IDD, or SUD needs.
DESIRED OUTCOME	To improve the identification of individuals with mental health, intellectual or developmental disabilities, or substance use disorders at book-in and initiate recommendations for most appropriate care.
