Re: Reconsider 2022 Historical Tax Abatement for 2 Properties

At the January 3rd Commissioners Court meeting Commissioners agreed to allow Clint Haggard to meet with the Collin County Historical committee to discuss and review the Aldridge House at 1615 Ave H. in Plano. Upon further review, the Tax Abatement Committee of the Collin County Historical Commission has issued a Follow Up Report and recommends the Aldridge House be approved for County Historic Property Tax Abatement for 2022.

The owner of the Dixie Watkins House at 403 Tucker Street in McKinney intended to attend the January 3<sup>rd</sup> Commissioners Court meeting to appeal his denial of the Tax Abatement for 2022. However, he was unable to attend and returned information to the Tax Abatement Committee. The committee submitted a Follow Up Report and recommends the Watkins House be approved for County Historic Property Tax Abatement for 2022.

Collin County Historical Commission requests Commissioners Court approval for these amendments for Historical Tax Abatement for tax year 2022.
