## **Project Abstract Girls Empowerment Mentoring Program**

Collin County is applying for funding in the amount \$525,000.00. The program will utilize a multidisciplinary approach, the program will effectively address underlying trauma associated with at-risk behaviors and related to delinquent conduct.

The Girl's Empowerment Mentoring Support (GEMS) Program will work with at-risk girls and juvenile offenders. The program will provide treatment/counseling for participants and group counseling/meetings with families, and seek to create places of healing for participants and family.

Goal: Will be to deliver services to girls who come in contact with the criminal justice system Objectives:

- 1. Ensure minimum of 95% of participants seeking assistance, deemed eligible for the GEMS committed to program are served.
- 2. Demonstrate maximum 30% increase yearly in participant enrollment.
- 3. Graduate 45 from project by 3rd year.

## Measures:

- 1. Provide assistance services to 50-60 participants (over the course of the three years).
- 2. Provide case management and advocacy for 60 participants (over the course of the three years).
- 3. Provide advocacy and assistance for participants.
- 4. Provide treatment referrals for 50 individuals (whether ultimately accepted into the GEMS Program or not) (over the course of the three years).
- 5. Assist 50 participants with developing plans (over the course of the three years).
