A resolution of the Collin County Commissioners Court, Collin County, Texas approving contracts for supplemental police, fire, emergency and animal control services with Raintree Municipal Utility District No. 1 of Collin County.

Whereas, Raintree Municipal Utility District No. 1 of Collin County (the "District") was created for the purpose of providing water, sanitary sewer and drainage facilities, and certain roads pursuant to House Bill No. 4665, 87th Texas Legislature, Regular Session, effective September 1, 2021, codified at Chapter 7937A, Special District Local Laws Code (the "Creation Legislation"), to serve the land within its boundaries; and

Whereas, Section 7937A.0104(a) of the Creation Legislation provides that the temporary directors of the District may not hold an election to confirm the creation of the District and elect permanent directors until the District has entered into a contract with a municipality, Collin County, or another entity (a) for adequate supplemental police, fire, emergency, and animal control services for the District; and (b) that is approved by the Commissioners Court of Collin County; and

Whereas, Section 7937A.0104(c) states that the Commissioners Court of Collin County shall review the contract for supplemental police, fire, emergency, and animal control services, and, if it is determined that the contract provides for adequate services, the Commissioners Court shall adopt a resolution stating that the contract has met the requirements of Section 7937A.0104(a); and

Whereas, the Commissioners Court has reviewed the (i) Fire Protection and EMS Services Agreement by and between the City of Princeton, Texas and, Raintree Municipal Utility District No. 1 of Collin County; (ii) Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for Law Enforcement Services by and between the Collin County, Texas and Raintree Municipal Utility District No. 1 of Collin County; and (iii) Interlocal Agreement for Animal Control and Animal Shelter Services by and between Collin County, Texas and Raintree Municipal Utility District No. 1 of Collin County (collectively, the "Agreements"); and

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Collin County Commissioners Court:

Section 1: That the facts set out in the preamble are true and correct and are incorporated herein for all purposes.


Section 2: That the Collin County Commissioners Court, Collin County, Texas has determined that the Agreements provide adequate services to the District and hereby adopts this Resolution stating that (i) the District and the Agreements have met the requirements of Section 7937A.0104(a) of the Texas Special District Local Laws Code; and (ii) the temporary directors of the District may hold an election to confirm the creation of the District and elect permanent directors.


A motion was duly made, seconded, and carried by a majority by the court members in attendance during a regular session on September 19, 2022.


