## Question Question from Zach Reynolds Ratcliff Constructors, LP on Monday, Dec 5, 2022 at 11:34 AM CST

During our last 2 OAC meetings, it was discussed that the 2 violent cells were not supposed to have toilets, and both cells are supposed to have the throw up toilet drain in the center of the rooms. Violent cell \#1119 has the throw up toilet in the cell per the plumbing plan on sheet P201 (fixture type DWC -5). However on sheet P202, cell \#1327 is called out to have a regular floor drain (fixture type FD-1): It is our understanding that the FD-1 floor drain needs to be replaced with the throw up toilet fixture DWC-5. Please advise if we can Sawcut the concrete as little as possible to remove the existing floor drain and install the throw up toilet fixture in cell \#1327. We will need to replace concrete as needed to remove the floor drain and hook up the plumbing to the new DWC-5.

It was also discussed that these 2 cells are not to have plumbing fixtures in these cells. Please advise if it is acceptable to cap the the toilet pipe rough in behind the chase wall. Additionally, advise if we are to give these 2 toilet fixtures to Collin County as attic stock, or return them to the manufacturer and give Collin County a credit back with associated restocking fee TBD.

## Official Response

Response from Michael Woods Brinkley Sargent Wiginton Architects on Tuesday, Dec 6, 2022 at 11:04 AM CST
The Owner has accepted the current conditions (no recesses in the slab) for both of these rooms. The padded flooring can be installed per the approved shop drawings. Plumbing can be capped in the chase walls.

Room 1119 - Remove DWC 3 and the SS partition in this room. Comply with the 8/A273. If possible, provide credit back for fixtures that are being removed form this room.
Room1327-Remove DWC 3 and the SS partition in this room. Comply with the 9/A273. If possible, provide credit back for fixtures that are being removed form this room. The floor drain in this room needs to be changed to a DWC 5 (flushable floor sink) as required by TCJS. This work cannot be proceeded with until Level 1 re-shores have been removed and Level 1 has cured.

Since the floor recesses were not installed per the A201, please submit pricing for the new DWC 5 (material only). The labor cost to install the new drain should be by the contractor.
