Issue No. 1 – The office cash box counted was \$5 dollars short [READACTED] made change and inadvertently took \$5 dollars too much. He was counseled on the importance of correctly counting money when making change. Issue No. 2 – [REDACTED] box was \$5 dollars over. It is not known why the overage occurred. The clerk was counseled on the importance of ensuring proper change is made when processing cash transactions. Issue No. 3 – [REDACTED] box was \$5 dollars over.		
The clerk took \$5 dollars too much when making change. The clerk was counseled on the importance of correctly counting money when making change. Protocols have been put in place to prevent the issue from occurring again.
