

ORDER OF THE COLLIN COUNTY, TEXAS COMMISSIONERS COURT
REQUESTING THE CITY OF JOSEPHINE, TEXAS TO ANNEX PORTIONS
OF COUNTY ROAD 689 AND COUNTY ROAD 1003

WHEREAS, County Roads 689 and 1003 (hereinafter "Roads"), are maintained by Collin County (hereinafter "County"); and

WHEREAS, the portion of the Roads in question are adjacent to and serve the City of Josephine's (hereinafter "City") wastewater treatment plant and holding pond; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to annex portions of the Roads to provide maintenance to support truck traffic and provide uninterrupted access to its infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, §43.1055 of the *Texas Local Government Code* authorizes a municipality to annex roads and right-of-way if requested by the entity responsible for maintenance of the roads, which in this case is Collin County; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court desires to work with the City; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court desires to request the City to annex the portions of the Roads shown on Exhibits "A" and "B" hereto, subject to the conditions herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF COLLIN COUNTY, TEXAS that:

1. the City is requested to annex the portion of County Road 689 described by map and fieldnotes in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein;
2. the City is requested to annex the portion of County Road 1003 described by map and fieldnotes attached hereto as Exhibit "B" and incorporated herein;
3. This request is conditioned on the Roads remaining public and open, the Roads not being gated or closed, and the Roads being maintained to at least the level of County maintenance.
