Attached is the FY 2024 Hazards renewal grant acceptance for the one year grant period of 7/1/2023-6/30/2024 in the amount of \$562,786 in the amount of level funding to support the county's Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHEP) activities. The County match required for this funding is \$56,278.60 and will be met by using existing staff members' salaries and fringe.

PHEP is a valuable source of funding for Collin County. The Hazards grant creates the ability to effectively prepare and respond to a range of public health threats, including infectious diseases, natural disasters, and biological, chemical, nuclear, and radiological events. PHEP follows the guidance of the CDC's fifteen public health capabilities, including; Community Preparedness and Recovery, Fatality Management, Public Health Surveillance and Epidemiological Investigation, Mass Care, and Volunteer Management (MRC). CCHCS plans to use the allocated DSHS Hazards funds towards the continuation of salaries and fringe costs for 7 current staff members. Other program costs such as mileage, travel for training, and supplies are included in the budget for review.
