**1. General Discussion Items:**

**Presentation, discussion and any action regarding:**

- a. AI-54980 Canvass the results of the November 7, 2023 General and Special Elections, Elections.

Bruce Sherbet, Elections Administrator, provided a report on the State Constitutional Amendment Election and the County Bond Election. There was a 14% turnout, which is double the turnout from two years ago and triple the turnout from 2017. Out of 2,200 mailed ballots, 1,785 were returned resulting in an 80% return rate. There were 20 provisional ballots counted, and 80 ballots were voted. Eight cities, three school districts, and six municipal utility districts were on the ballot. The turnout on Election Day was very heavy compared to previous years, which points to additional voting locations needing to be found. (Time 1:32 p.m.)
