Collin County Animal Services Division (CCASD) will host both events at the Brandon Tomes Subaru in McKinney. CCASD will advertise the event on social media as well as have fliers sent out (with ASPCA approval). We will have a table and space for Brandon Tomes staff to be there and speak to the community/public coming in. There will be two lines on the side of the building for the vaccination clinic

and another line at the front of the building for adoptions. CCASD Veterinarian will check each pet before shots and microchips are given and procedure is completed. There will be a team of volunteers in the building to work with adopters (due to paperwork that will need to be completed) to match families with the perfect animal for them. The Veterinarian will be on site to answer questions and/or concerns related to vaccines and adoptions.

CCAS will offer (to the first 100 community animals at each event) dog/cat-specific, core vaccines for \$15 per pet and we will offer a free microchip implantation for each of the 100 vaccinated animals. We will also offer ½ price animal adoptions for all animals adopted during the course of each event.

There will also be local businesses out to hand out treats and 'swag' to the community/public coming in.

2. How will you and your Subaru retailer partner market the collaboration event and involve the media in the event?

CCASD will post the event on all of our social media pages (with ASPCA prior approval) which have over 79,500 following. CCASD will also advertise with local businesses that we partner with to promote to their customers. Brandon Tomes Subaru will also assist with the advertisement.

There will also be family photos out front with a photographer.
