Pathology in the Mountains – June 24–27, 2024

The 2024 Pathology in the Mountains program will focus on cytopathology, gastrointestinal, genitourinary, and head and neck/endocrine pathology. Sessions will take place during the morning hours, leaving afternoons free for participants to explore the venue with their families or colleagues and take advantage of its many activities.

Features of Pathology in the Mountains include:

CAD \$535.00 + \$25.00 Resort Fee + 16% tax - Deluxe Four Seasons Executive Suite

***Run of House** room category includes a combination of Resort King, Superior King, Deluxe King Rooms, and Premier King Rooms, and room choices will be based on hotel availability. Resort King Rooms and Superior Rooms can only hold a maximum of 2 adults per room. Should there be a request for a third adult, a Deluxe Room with a pull-out sofa will be necessary.

Sleeping room rates are based on one or two adults per room. A charge of \$50.00 per room per night will be assessed for a third adult, plus applicable taxes and fees. No additional charge for children under the age of 18 years old if staying in the parents' room.
