SUMMARY	This allocation of opioid abatement funds will be utilized to continue the Collin County Opioid Response Team that was established with the initial allocation of funds in July of 2023. This specialized team facilitates a warm handoff transition into substance abuse treatment and recovery services for Collin County residents who have recently experienced an opioid overdose. Referrals are received from emergency departments, schools, law enforcement, and other local partners.		
DESIRED OUTCOME	To ensure individuals struggling with an opioid addiction are identified and engaged into the most appropriate level of care. The goal is to decrease opioid related deaths and establish long term recovery for individuals who have abused opioids.		
PROJECTED BUDGET	\$77,360.02 annual budget will go towards salary for 1.7 FTE project staff (\$45,000 per year per 1.0 FTE).		
DESCRIPTION OF PROGRAM	Qualified Mental Health Professionals provide services during office hours and evenings and weekends as needed. Team reaches out to individuals referred and coordinates screenings and assessments for referral into other State-funded substance use programs (such as detox, residential treatment, medication assisted treatment, outpatient groups, etc.). The team also provides trainings to members of the community on the use of Narcan and provides Narcan to interested parties as available.
