WHEREAS, the Rogers Cultural Education Facilities Finance Corporation (the "Corporation") created by the City of Rogers, Texas has adopted a resolution authorizing the proposed loan (the "Loan") in the maximum principal amount of \$5,600,000 under a loan agreement among the Corporation, North Dallas Bank & Trust Co. (the "Bank") and Lucas Christian Academy, Inc. WHEREAS, attached hereto as <u>Exhibit A</u> is a Publisher's Affidavit certifying that notice of the public hearing was published in a newspaper of general circulation in the County as required by section 147(f) of the Code and the Certificate of Public Hearing certifying that the public hearing was held; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF COLLIN COUNTY, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1. The County hereby specifically approves the Loan and the Project solely for the purpose of satisfying the requirements of section 147(f) of the Code and for no other purpose and is not to be construed as an undertaking by the County. The Loan shall not constitute a liability, an indebtedness or obligation of the County nor shall any of the assets of the County be pledged to the payment of the Loan.

Section 2. The County Judge is authorized to execute and deliver this Resolution.

Section 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.


