RE: Appointment of Election Judges and Alternate Election Judges

Pursuant to Section 32.002 of the Texas Election Code, the Commissioners Court is required to appoint the election judges and alternate judges for each county polling place and the central counting station, from lists submitted by the political party county chairs. State law mandates that the election judge and alternate election judge designations are determined using a formula based on the most recent gubernatorial election.

Attached precinct designation report indicates which political party received the highest number of votes in each of the County's 252 voting precincts based on the 2022 Gubernatorial Election.

Attached are lists of recommendations from the Collin County Democratic Party and Collin County Republican Party for the appointment of election judges and alternate judges for the 2024-2026 term which runs from August 5, 2024 through July 31, 2026.

Attached are the recommendations for the appointment of Central Counting Station judge and alternate judge.
