A resolution of the Collin County Commissioners Court opposing taxpayer-funded lobbying.

Whereas, taxpayers should not be required to pay for lobbying efforts that advocate against their own interests or to influence legislators for causes they do not support; and

Whereas, banning taxpayer-funded lobbying is a legislative priority for the Republican Party of Texas, and has been since 2018; and

Resolved, that the Collin County Commissioners Court opposes taxpayer-funded lobbying by all political subdivisions and holds that legislation prohibiting taxpayer-funded lobbying should apply equally to all political subdivisions.

A motion was made, seconded, and carried by a majority of the court members in attendance during a regular session on Monday, November 11, 2024.




