Monarch Girls Academy - 9 Month Placement- Monarch Academy caters to young girls who have a history of sex trafficking and chronic runaway. Monarch provides a diverse range a therapy techniques, along with individualized plans for education. There are many extercurrical activities to become inolved ranging from music to cheerleading. It provides a safe place to learn, while being surrounded by other girls who have similar histories of trauma. Specific services that would help the applicant would be the following:1. The use of an Integrated Care Model allows for a tailored approach to meet her individual needs.

1. The use of an Integrated Care Model allows for a tailored approach to meet her individual needs. 2. A family engagement program will facilitate positive communication with family members and help her navigate her roles as a mother, daughter, and sister. 3. Trauma-Informed Care is essential for as she would benefit from a variety of treatment services, not just therapy. She will require assistance in building lasting relationships with peers, strengthening her confidence, and developing a supportive network to address substance abuse issues and the potential need to engage in prostitution. requires a secure facility along with an intensive therapy program. Monarch Academy meets these needs and will help prevent her from running away, as she has done in the past with other PHPs she has been admitted to for help.
