YOU ARE DIRECTED TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING MODIFICATION TO THIS CONTRACT

1) Renew this contract for an additional twelve (12) month period. Renewal period: 12/17/2024 - 12/16/2025

2) Compliance with FCC Orders:

Collin County and Inmate Calling Solutions, LLC (Contractor) acknowledge that the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) has issued various orders regarding the provision of telephone services to inmates in correctional facilities, including but not limited to 47 CFR 14, 64 [WC Docket Nos. 12-375, 23-62; FCC 24-75; FR ID 237400]. Accordingly, the Contractor and the County agree to amend the terms of the inmate telephone services provided under this Agreement to fully comply with all applicable FCC rules, regulations, and orders, including but not limited to (1) Rate Cap Compliance; (2) Fee Transparency and Disclosure; (3) Call Blocking and Disconnection; (4) Collect Calling Restrictions, or (5) Monetary and In-Kind Site Commissions.

a) Refunds and Credits: In the event that any telephone services are charged in violation of applicable FCC regulations, the Contractor shall promptly refund or credit any overcharges to inmates or their designated account holders.

b) Implementation of Changes: The Contractor agrees to implement all necessary changes to ensure compliance with any future amendments or updates to FCC orders or related regulations within a reasonable time frame and at no additional cost to the facility.

c) Minimum Annual Guarantee (MAG): The County and Contractor agree to temporarily freeze the MAG until the County makes a final determination regarding the effective date of the FCC IPCS monetary commission. Once the effective date is established, the County reserves the right to recover any past-due or unpaid commissions in accordance with the FCC IPCS rules.

Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions of the contract remain in full force and effect and may only be modified in writing signed by both parties.
