Subject: Approval of the Collin County Term 4 (2025-2028) Storm Water Management Program and submission of the Notice of Intent (NOI) and Core Data Form to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ).

On August 15, 2024, TCEQ re-issued the Phase II Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4s) Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) General Permit No. TXR040000. This permit requires regulated governmental entities to develop, implement and enforce a Storm Water Management Program (SWMP) to reduce the discharge of pollutants in storm water to the “maximum extent practicable” in the urbanized areas of the regulated entity.

This is the fourth permit term since the program started on August 13, 2007. LJA has prepared the NOI and SWMP that will cover the calendar years from 2025-2028. LJA, in coordination with the Collin County Engineering staff, and based on County stakeholders input, created a program that implements Best Management Practices (BMPs) that best fit Collin County’s needs and fulfills the requirements of the new permit. A full list of BMPs can be found in the attached SWMP document.

The NOI and Core Data form (attached) will need to be electronically submitted by Judge Hill to the TCEQ by February 11, 2025. Staff will work with the Judge to get this completed.

ACTION:
