- 1. Is the ROW for turn lanes acquire?
  - a. Yes
- 2. Has funding been allocated?
  - a. Yes for the engineering service.
- 3. Are there utility challenges at the intersections?
  - a. There shouldn't be any, 500 ft have been cleared.
- 4. Does ROW need to be acquired back to the east?
  - a. No, we have all the Right of Way. If needed we can build lane back to the east.
- 5. If right of way & utilities are good, what about environmental?
  - a. There should be no need for an environmental analysis since the No, **r**ight of **w**ay is all cleared. There will also be no need for public involvement.
- 6. What is the status of improvements on EUS75?
  - a. There are **n**o plans that we know of.
- 7. The bridges have walkways, will pedestrian elements be needed in the project?
  - a. No, sidewalks will not be extended.
- 8. What about traffic counts?
  - a. That will be part of the job.
- 9. Do you anticipate any new geotechnical work needed?
  - a. We do not anticipate it but cannot rule it out. The County has a contract for geotechnical services if needed.
- 10. What times of day are the roads most congested?
  - a. First thing in the morning. But **w**e need to look at all peaks, may need to do something for those.
