
An order of the Collin County Commissioners Court approving an interlocal agreement.


A motion was made, seconded, and carried by a majority of the court members in attendance during a regular session on Monday, December 16, 2024.







Attached is the invoice for Collin County's portion of the Stone Road improvement project, extending from WA Allen Boulevard to Bennett Road. As approved by the Wylie City Council on May 27, 2025, the project has been awarded to Texas Materials.

The total project cost, including a 10% contingency, is \$6,809,012.

- The City of Wylie will contribute \$4,970,579 (73%).
- We are respectfully requesting Collin County's contribution of \$1,838,433 (27%), per the agreed-upon funding ratio.

This project is a vital infrastructure improvement that supports mobility, safety, and growth for both the City of Wylie and the broader Collin County region. We appreciate the County's continued support and collaboration.
