Court Order

An order of the Collin County Commissioners Court approving mandatory payment rate for fiscal year 2026.

The Collin County Commissioners Court hereby authorizes the County to continue to participate in the Collin County local health care provider participation program subject to Chapter 292E of the Texas Health and Safety Code and further approves the following:

All references to Chapter 300 of the Texas Health and Safety Code in the Collin County Health Care Provider Participation Program Rules and Procedures (adopted on December 4, 2023) are replaced with Chapter 292E of the Texas Health and Safety Code.

Rule 10(c)(i) of Collin County Health Care Provider Participation Program Rules and Procedures is deleted and replaced in its entirety to now state "The annual amount of revenue from the mandatory payments used for administrative expenses of the county for activities under these rules and procedures is \$300,000, plus the cost of collateralization of deposits, regardless of actual expenses."

The fiscal year 2026 mandatory payment rate applicable to the Collin County local provider participation program shall be 6.0% of the net patient revenue of an institutional health care provider located in Collin County, and revenue derived from those payments is to be spent in accordance with Section 292E.103(b) of the Texas Health and Safety Code as detailed in the attached documentation.

A motion was made, seconded, and carried by a majority of the court members in attendance during a regular session on Monday, September 8, 2025.
