RE: Boundary Changes to Voting Precincts

Request Commissioners Court consideration and approval of the attached voting precinct boundary changes.

Growth within Collin County has resulted in twenty-one voting precincts that exceed the maximum number of registered voters allowed in a voting precinct. Section 42.006(a) of the Texas Election Code prohibits voting precincts from containing more than 5,000 registered voters. Per Section 42.006(e), in computing a number of registered voters under this section, voters whose names appear on the list of registered voters with the notation "S" or similar notation, shall be excluded.

In addition, nine precincts with fewer than 150 active voters will be combined with an existing precinct.

Also, Texas legislators recently approved PLANC2333 which redistricted four congressional districts within the State of Texas. Three of the four districts addressed in PLANC2333 touch Collin County. This new plan created an additional nine precincts as the newly drawn congressional lines went through already-existing Collin County precincts. An additional fifty-one precincts had congressional district changes, as they were drawn into a new congressional district.

If approved, a Notice of Precinct Boundary Changes will be published in the Dallas Morning News once a week for three consecutive weeks, per Section 42.035 of the Texas Election Code. Voting precinct changes will be effective January 1, 2026.
