Michael,

Please find the pricing attached for SEDALCO Change Proposal #CO-102. This cost is associated with the additional caulking required at the top of fire and smoke rated walls. The Contract Documents call for a 1" gap between the top of CMU walls and the concrete deck above, but in order to fully grout the walls as required there must be a 2" gap for the equipment needed to pour the grout. This has created a need for an additional caulking to fill the wider gap. SEDALCO has proposed eliminating the acoustical caulking at the top of non-rated walls to help offset this cost.

The cost of this change is \$15,840.42. Upon acceptance of this proposal, please issue a Change Order to the Contract to reflect the added cost.

- A. All joints average 2" wide (varies from 1.5" to 2.25" wide) at locations based on plans provided.
- B. CMU to Deck Joints
- C. Notes:
 - 1. Fire Rated Joints up to 2" wide will receive 3M FD 150+ with Mineral wood
 - 1. Joint backing material to be Rockwool Roxul Safe Mineral Wool
 - i. Approx. approx.. 3,355 lf. of 2" joint.
 - 2. Fire rated joints over 2" will be 4" 3M tape with mineral wool.
