## **Description/Justification:**

On Monday, June 9, 2025, the Collin County Commissioners Court voted unanimously to direct county staff to develop a plan for implementing an in-person Ballot on Demand (BOD) delivery system at countywide polling locations for the upcoming November 4, 2025 Constitutional Amendment Election. The Commissioners Court reconvened on Monday, June 23, 2025, and approved the proposed BOD implementation plan. The estimated cost of implementing the BOD system is approximately \$2.3 million. The plan includes the purchase of laptops, printers, software and licensing, barcode scanners, backup printer components, transport bags for curbside voting with ADA-compliant units, voting privacy booths, and storage carts for delivering the BOD systems to polling locations.
