The Collin County Constable's Office, Precinct 4, respectfully requests approval to apply for the FY2026 Bullet-Resistant Components for Law Enforcement Vehicles Grant through the Office of the Governor, Public Safety Office.

This grant opportunity provides funding to equip law enforcement vehicles with ballistic door panels and window inserts designed to enhance deputy safety during high-risk duties such as warrant service, civil enforcement, and emergency response operations. The project will improve officer protection without requiring any county match.
