

RESOLUTION NO. 2025- 75 R

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CELINA,  
TEXAS, RENAMING COUNTY ROAD 97 TO NORTH COIT ROAD.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Celina adopted a revised street name approval policy, and map with historic name placeholders on May 12, 2015;

**WHEREAS**, policies of the City are revised from time-to-time;

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Celina desires to honor the historic heritage of the early families who settled in Celina; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Celina also desires to recognize prominent citizens, both living and deceased;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CELINA, TEXAS:**

**SECTION 1:** The following street names shall be changed effective January 1<sup>st</sup>, pending corresponding County approval in December. Street placards shall be replaced with the adopted names, and notice shall be given to property owners along such streets of the official change:

- County Road 97, from the intersection with Lynn Stambaugh Pkwy as its most Southern point, and the intersection with County Road 134 as its most Northern point shall become North Coit Road, as depicted in Exhibit A.


**SECTION 2:** The City Council reviewed the revised Policy and hereby adopts the same,

**SECTION 3:** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.


